

Anthemios Graduate Scholarship

Criteria for the Awarding of the Scholarship

The Anthemios Alumni Association will award a recipient each summer with the Anthemios Graduate Scholarship. The award amount will be determined by the Association board and will be sourced from the Anthemios Alumni Association's managed fund held by the Alpha Rho Chi Foundation. The Alumni Association's board will judge the scholarship.

Eligibility

The scholarship is available to all brothers who are enrolled in a graduate program for the fall following their application. Award of the scholarship is an individual competition based on the criteria below. Elected officers of the Anthemios Alumni Association and previous winners of the Scholarship are not eligible for the award.

Submittal

Candidates for consideration will submit the completed attached application sheet, verification of their enrollment of a graduate course of study for the following fall semester (or equivalent), and an essay. Applications can be submitted to the alumni association treasurer at treasurer.anthemiosalumni@gmail.com

Essay

Candidates will submit an essay discussing what brotherhood after graduation from the University of Illinois means to them, the benefits of continued brotherhood after graduation, and how they have demonstrated and/or encouraged brotherhood after graduation. There is no minimum of maximum length required, however, applicants are encouraged to provide an essay with sufficient length to adequately and concisely convey their thoughts. Longer essays will not receive preference .

Judging

The Anthemios Alumni Association board will judge and administer the scholarship. The Treasurer of the board will oversee the distribution, collection, and judging of the scholarship and will forward application materials to the other officers being sure to remove identifying information from each application. The President, Vice President, and Secretary will blindly judge the scholarship and decide the winner by simple majority.

Deadline

The deadline for applications will be the end of day April 1st. Applications must be received and dated April 1st or earlier to be judged. Judging will conclude no later than April 15th.

Award

The scholarship will be awarded to one applicant. The amount awarded will be determined by the board as funds are available. The board has the option to not award the scholarship.
